

How to Apply for Admissions as a NEW FRESHMAN

Am I a New Freshman?

- You are a **new freshman** at USC Lancaster if you have enrolled in classes at any other college or university* since graduating from high school.
- Students who took dual enrollment courses will submit the <u>New Freshman</u> application, and provide official transcripts for all completed college coursework, even if no credit was earned or will be applied.
- If you previously enrolled at another USC campus during the most recent semester, you will submit a Change of Campus Application.
- If you attended any USC campus after high school and it has been at at least one full semester since you last attended, you will submit a Readmit Application.
- If you previously enrolled at a college or university* (outside of USC) after graduating from high school, you will submit a Transfer Application.

New Freshman Admission Requirements:

- Complete the Online Application
 - > Access the online application by visiting my.sc.edu/lancaster/apply.
 - o If you have never applied before, select "Sign Up" beneath the Login
 - o Log In to begin the application process.
 - o If you are a previous dual enrollment student, you will need to sign in.
- Pay the Application Fee
 - ➤ Pay the \$40 application fee online or in person at the Admissions Office.
 - o If you need a link to pay, email uscladms@mailbox.sc.edu.
 - o If you have an application fee waiver, enter the code when applying.
- Send Official Transcripts
 - > If you're currently in high school, submit your most recent transcript.
 - > After you graduate, you must submit your official final high school transcript.
 - > Submit college transcripts for any dual enrollment credits earned outside USC.

New Freshman Enrollment Requirements:

Proof of Immunization

- > Submit the completed Immunization Form.
- > Provide acceptable proof of immunizations or appropriate waivers.
 - o Two doses of MMR are considered acceptable proof.

Proof of Citizenship

- Submit the completed Citizenship Verification Form.
- > Provide acceptable proof of citizenship.
 - For U.S. citizens, acceptable forms of identification include:
 U.S. Passport, Birth Certificate, or South Carolina Driver's License
 - o **For permanent residents**, color copy of your Permanent Resident Card, both front and back.
 - o If you are not a United States Citizen or Permanent resident, or have other questions, contact our office: uscladms@mailbox.sc.edu.

Proof of Name Change

- ➤ If your name has changed at any time since birth and that name is listed on any of these documents (transcripts, test scores, immunization records, or citizenship documents), you must **submit the Name Change Form.**
- > Send proof of your name change:
 - Marriage license, divorce decree, adoption documents, court order, valid passport, or birth certificate are considered acceptable proof.

New Freshman Optional Requirements:

Test Scores

- ➤ Have your official SAT or ACT scores sent directly from the testing agency (CollegeBoard.org or ACT student.org) to USC Lancaster.
- > Test Scores may be required for certain scholarships (e.g. Palmetto Fellows)
- If you have earned any AP, IB, CLEP Course Work that does not appear on your high school transcript, you must have that sent to our Admissions Office.
- If you have attended any college or university*, even if you did not complete the coursework, you must submit the official transcripts.

What happens next?

- We will review your application for all requirements.
- If we are missing any documents, we will contact you by email and text.
- Once completed, you will receive our acceptance decision by email and by mail.
- Your admissions letter will include instructions on Claiming your Account
